NATIONAL TRYOUT OF THE 1989 FIRST YEAR HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Chief of Service and Heads of Centers/Units  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports will conduct a tryout on a pilot basis of the 1989 First Year High School Curriculum in the different regions this school year 1985-1986.
2. The objectives of the tryout are: (a) to validate the learning competencies for the First Year and (b) to determine the threshold requirements for the implementation of the curriculum.
3. The tryout is intended to answer the following questions:
  - To what extent are the objectives set in the curriculum accomplished at the end of the school year?
  - What major factors influence the students' achievement?
  - What are the students, teachers, administrators and the general public's perceptions of the proposed curriculum? instructional materials?
  - In what areas are the teachers strong/weak in relation to the implementation of the curriculum?
  - What problems are encountered by the teachers and administrators in the implementation of the 1989 First Year Curriculum?
4. A total of 80 high schools (national, provincial, municipal/city, vocational, barangay, private sectarian, private non-sectarian) will be included in the tryout. See Inclosure No. 1 (List of Tryout Schools)
5. Expenses incurred by the tryout schools in transporting the textbooks from Manila to their respective addresses shall be chargeable against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
6. Details of the tryout which were discussed with the teachers and principals during the 1985 summer training of tryout teachers are contained in the attached guidelines. See Inclosure No. 2.







7. In view of the importance of the tryout, the field is enjoined to extend full cooperation to ensure its success.

Guidelines on the Macro Tryout of the First Year Curriculum  
1985-86

1. The tryout schools are those listed in Inclosure No. 1
2. Tryout classes in each school:
  - a) One pilot class and one non-pilot class consisting of forty (40) First Year students each should be organized.
  - b) Each class should consist of students of different ability levels, i.e.,

Fair . . . . .	13 students
Average . . . . .	14 students
Above Average . . . . .	13 students
  - c) Students' general average in Grade 6 or the results of entrance examinations in high school should be considered in determining the ability level of students.
  - d) The 1989 Curriculum and its instructional materials will be used by pilot classes; the 1973 Revised Secondary Education Curriculum and its instructional materials by the non-pilot classes.
  - e) Tryout classes should be organized by July 1, 1985.
  - f) Instructional materials for the 1989 Curriculum should be used only after the administration of the pre-test scheduled from July 1 to July 26, 1985, and will be considered terminated after the administration of the post-test tentatively set for February or March 1986.
3. Tryout Teachers
  - a) Tryout teachers should have not less than 4 teaching loads nor more than 7 teaching loads.
  - b) For pilot classes, teachers should have attended the 1985 summer training for tryout teachers; for non-pilot classes, non-participants in the 1985 summer training for tryout teachers.
  - c) Comments and suggestions of tryout teachers of pilot classes on the instructional materials may be given in the form of marginal notes to be indicated on the pages of the teacher's manual and textbook, to be retrieved at the end of the tryout.
  - d) In assessing student performance, tryout teachers should use the schools' own grading system unless otherwise directed.
4. Others:
  - a) Principals of participating schools and tryout teachers should accomplish forms and reports pertinent to the tryout in triplicate (1 copy each for the division, the region and the Bureau of Secondary Education).
  - b) Details of the tryout are contained in the handout "Macro Tryout Scheme" distributed to the principals of the tryout schools and
