SEVENTH FAI PHILIPPINE FOLK FESTIVAL

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors

1. The Folk Arts Theater (FAT) will hold its Seventh Philippine Folk Festival on July 7-11, 1985. Traditionally, the Philippine Folk Festival features a national dance workshop, cultural nights of songs and dances, a food festival and week-long trade exhibit of arts and crafts of the participating provinces.
2. This year, the festival will have a competition in music, dance and costume. Cash prizes at stake for the winners are P10,000.00 (First Prize), P7,000.00 (Second Prize) and P5,000.00 (Third Prize). Trophies and plaques of appreciation will also be given. The regions are encouraged to join this competition.
3. A national folk dance workshop for teachers, administrators, supervisors, recreation leaders and other folk dance enthusiasts will also be held. In this connection, the regions may send representatives to the clinic on official time.
4. A registration fee of three hundred pesos (P300.00) will be charged each participant in the workshop. The registration and travel expenses incident to the attendance in the festival-workshop shall be charged against local funds, subject to availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
5. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
