VITALIZING THE ACTIVITIES OF THE FUTURE FARMERS AND THE FUTURE  
AGRICULTURAL HOMEMAKERS OF THE PHILIPPINES  
FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 1985-1986

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
School Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators/Principals

1. The major activities of the Future Farmers of the Philippines and the Future Agricultural Homemakers of the Philippines (FFP/FAHP) during the school year 1985-86 shall focus on the theme: "Vitalizing the FFP and FAHP Activities to Help Implement Saaring Sikap Projects in Secondary Schools. The selected activities to be undertaken during the year should conform with the chapter objectives and be responsive to the needs of the members and the community based on self-help, self-reliance and self-sufficiency.

2. All activities of the FFP/FAHP members shall immediately start after the opening of classes. Preparations for the chapter week celebration should be done at least one month before the scheduled dates of regional work-conferences to give adequate time to practice or train contestants and delegates in the skills and abilities and in participating in the deliberations.

3. The vitalized activities that may be undertaken during the chapter week celebration should include awards programs, agricultural fairs and exhibits, skills demonstrations, community assemblies, symposia where successful farmers in the community are invited to participate. These activities, together with individual skills and talents contests are calculated to make the affair more meaningful and functional.

4. The Regional Chairman should convene an official meeting of the local advisory board to discuss the dates and venues of their regional work conference and plan out the activities to be undertaken during the regional work conference. Involvement of student officers is suggested to develop their interest and gain their support.

5. The Regional Chairman should immediately submit to this Office the tentative dates and venues of the regional work-conference, the list of regional officers, and the plan of work/activities for SY 1985-1986.

6. It is desired that this Memorandum be given the widest publicity possible for the information and guidance of all concerned.
