CALENDAR OF SCIENCE EDUCATION ACTIVITIES FOR SY 1985-1986

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chief of Service and Heads of Units/Centers
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. Inclosed, for the information of the field, is the 1985-1986 Calendar of Science Education Activities as prepared by the Science Promotion Institute, NSTA and the Ministry of Education Joint Executive Committee.
2. The activities are designed to promote and develop science and technology consciousness among the youth and the general public through the organization and mobilization of science clubs in schools, colleges and universities of the country.
3. The Calendar starts with activities for the celebration of the National Science Club Month in September conformably to Presidential Proclamation No. 1895, dated September 4, 1979. Other activities are the Sighep Awards, Herbal and Medicinal Garden Contest, Rank Advancement Program, Survey Research of Science Clubs, 1985 Search for TOYS (district level up to the national level), Science Camps, Philippine Mathematical Olympiad, Youth Research Apprenticeship Action Program, Science Club Advisers Leadership Training Program, Energy Related Projects, and activities of the Youth Science Clubs as well as those of the Science Club Advisers Association.
4. It is emphasized that these activities are intended to support the science and mathematics programs of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports and the development of aesthetic and social values of the young. The participation/involvement of the school pupils and studentry in these activities is basically voluntary in nature. However, the cooperation and support of all concerned is hereby earnestly requested to ensure the effective and successful conduct and implementation of these activities. Care should be exercised in undertaking such activities to avoid undue disruption of or interference with the regular school program.
5. SPI-NSTA representatives shall work out the details of implementation of the various activities at local levels with the school official concerned. The regional directors take care of regional activities and the schools division superintendents, in the case of division activities.

6. Regional and division supervisors and teachers of Science and Mathematics; science-math club advisors and members and all others involved in the promotion of Science and Mathematics such as the non-formal education coordinators, school paper advisors and campus writers, and the students are enjoined to extend the cooperation as well as maximize their support, attendance and actual participation in the calendared activities.

7. Travel expenses incident to the participation of those concerned in national level activities shall be provided by the SPI-NSTA. Interested participants who would like to attend the national, regional and local activities will be allowed official time only. They shall solicit assistance from appropriate sponsors to finance their travel expenses.

8. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum should be disseminated to all concerned.
