DIALOGUES ON AGRICULTURE EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. By invitation, the Technical Panel for Agricultural Education (TPAE) of the Ministry will conduct a series of dialogues on agricultural education and allied programs, i.e. agriculture, fishery, forestry, veterinary medicine and agricultural engineering, starting October 18, 1985, with the following aims:

- a. To discuss the results of the school evaluations on the various agriculture education programs as authorized through MECS Memorandum No. 197, s. 1981, vis-a-vis the MECS minimum standards prescribed for the said programs, including some vital issues/problems concerning agriculture education in the country; and
- b. To arrive at a decision based on the results of the school evaluations on actions to take for possible reorientation, phasing out or continuing the offering of certain degree courses in agriculture education and allied programs towards a more rationalized, purposive and improved system of agricultural education in the Philippines.

2. The series of dialogues for the various sectors shall be held as follows:

Participants in the dialogues will be the heads of schools, colleges and universities offering agriculture, fishery and allied programs, panel members, TP&E Technical Committee members, MECS regional directors and the chiefs of the Higher Education Division, representatives from OBN and other government agencies and TP&E secretariat.

5. Food and conference materials will be provided by TP&E. However, transportation and other expenses incidental to the attendance in these dialogues are chargeable against the funds of the school/office concerned, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

6. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is enjoined.
