Application forms may be obtained from and filed with the Examination Administration Division, Office of Recruitment and Examination, Civil Service Commission, Diliman, Q.C., or the Civil Service Commission Regional Office or the Office of the Schools Superintendent in the examination center where the applicant desires to take the examination not later than October 7, 1985.

3. Applicants are advised to check carefully whether they meet the admission requirements before they apply, otherwise their applications will be disapproved and the admission fee of P50.00 will be forfeited. Points scored from unauthorized or illegal sources shall be considered sufficient ground for disqualifying an applicant from taking the examination.
4. Teachers in the service who are not yet eligible should be encouraged to take the examination.
5. It is desired that this Memorandum be given immediate publicity.
