SELECTION OF SCHOLARS UNDER THE PANGULO SCHOLARSHIP  
PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL YEAR 1986-87

1. The National Scholarship and Student Loan Center (NSSLC), this Ministry, in coordination with the Pambansang Katipunan ng mga Kabataang Barangay (PKKB), announces the opening of an unlimited number of scholarship slots/berths under the Pangulo Scholarship Program (PSP) for school year 1986-1987.

2. The PSP, a student financial scheme sponsored by the PKKB with the NSSLC as administering agency and designed to developing the leadership potentials of the Kabataang Barangay (KB) officers and members, is now in its fourth year of successful implementation.

3. Selected scholars should enroll in any of the following prescribed courses and schools:

9. Applicants should wait for notification from PKKB on the results of their applications.

CRITERIA AND OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION ON THE SELECTION OF SCHOOL YEAR 1986-1987 SCHOLARS UNDER THE PANGULO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

A. Qualification Criteria

An applicant must possess the following qualifications:

1. He must be an active officer/member of the KB.
2. He must belong to the upper ten (10) per cent of the fourth year graduating class.
3. He must qualify in the U.P. College of Admission Test (UPCAT) for school year 1986-1987 which will be administered nationwide by U.P. on October 19-20, 1985 in designated test center (the high school principal should now be contacted for this purpose).
4. His National College Entrance Examination (NCEE) must be 80th percentile rank or above.
5. His parents' joint or court-appointed guardian's gross income in 1985 is P30,000 or less.
6. He must be willing and able to present himself for personal interview by the Educational Development Department-PKKB (travel and other related/incidental expenses will be borne by the applicant).

B. Documents Required

An applicant should submit the following documents:

1. Certification by the KB Regional Manager that he possesses excellent potentials of a community leader (a complete listing of KB Regional Managers and their addresses are contained in letter C of this inclosure).
2. Certification by the high school principal that (a) he belong to the upper ten (10) per cent of the fourth year class indicating his definite/exact class rank and average, and (b) he possesses excellent moral character.
3. A copy of his UPCAT results or an authenticated reproduction thereof.
4. A copy of his NCEE rating or an authenticated reproduction thereof.
5. A copy of parents' joint or court-appointed guardian's 1985 BIR Income Tax Return.
