REGIONAL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE INTEGRATED CONTINUING EDUCATION  
FOR FAMILIES OF OVERSEAS CONTRACT WORKERS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents

1. Pursuant to MECS Memorandum No. 135, s. 1985, the implementation phase of the "Integrated Continuing Education for Families of Overseas Contract Workers" will be held in the different regions of the country which will cover a three-month period, October to December, based on the approved Regional Work Plans.
2. The regional implementation includes the following activities; (a) Formulation of Regional Research Teams; (b) Research on the Needs/ Problems of the Families of Overseas Contract Workers; (c) Identification of Problems, Needs and Proposing Alternatives; (d) Choice of Alternative Solutions; (e) Development of Appropriate Educational Materials and Strategies; (f) Validating Materials and Strategies; and (g) Submission of Reports.
3. In order to effectively attain the goals/objectives of the project, and to successfully come up with the expected output, it is necessary that those who attended the national workshop on the above-named subject at DAP, Tagaytay City, be assigned to serve as the team leader and members of the implementing teams of their respective regions.
4. Within the scheduled period for the implementation phase, duly designated researchers and other personnel from the Bureau of Continuing Education will monitor the different activities of the project to determine the extent of implementation and to give possible assistance to the organized regional teams.
5. Moderate funding assistance will be provided by the BCE for the purchase of supplies and materials needed in the project and travel allotment for community immersion of the research team, including payment of honoraria, subject to the usual accounting and auditing requirements.
6. Submission of the expected output at the end of each month from October to December to the BCE, MECS, is mandatory.
7. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be brought immediately to the attention of all concerned.
