- 3. The inclusion of the Minister's name as member of the Sight Saving Club "edvisory council" and the printing of a general letter from the undersigned used for the purpose of exacting dues or contributions are not authorized.
- In this connection, this Office enjoins all concerned to desist from contributing to any fund campaigns or from payment of any dues to such an organization, and to submit to this Office (Attn.: Head Executive Assistant's Office) a copy of their membership report participation, through their Regional Directors, for immediate and appropriate action.
- Immediate and wide dissemination of this is enjoined.
