TRAINING AT INTERNATIONAL STATISTICAL EDUCATION CENTRE

1. The Fortieth Term of the International Statistical Education Centre, Calcutta, India will be held from 01 June 1986 to March 1987, jointly conducted by UNESCO and the Indian Statistical Institute. Inclosed is a copy of the announcement-letter and a copy of the application form.
2. Interested participants may apply for the training program through the Bureau of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, Palacio del Gobernador, Intramuros, Manila not later than December 15, 1985, c/o the Secretariat for International Education Matters.
3. Classroom, laboratory and field instruction are provided free of charge, but participants or their institutions are expected to provide for travel, living and other expenses.
4. It is suggested that professional statisticians and prominent administrative officers be nominated for the above training program.
5. Dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is requested.

Excellency,

I have the honour to inform Your Excellency of the Fortieth Term of the International Statistical Education Centre at Calcutta. The Centre is jointly operated by the International Statistical Institute and the Indian Statistical Institute with the support of the Government of India and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO).

The previous terms have been attended by about twenty-five students on the average. These students, who were selected from a large number of applicants, came from Afghanistan, Australia, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Brunei, Burma, Cambodia, Egypt, Ethiopia, Fiji Islands, Hong-Kong, India, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Japan, Kenya, Republic of Korea, Laos, Malaysia, Malawi, Maldives, Mauritius, Nepal, New Zealand, Nigeria, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Sarawak, Sierra Leone, Singapore, Somalia, South Africa, Sri Lanka, St. Christopher Nevis, Syria, Tanzania, Thailand, Uganda, Viet Nam and Zambia. It is believed that they are fully justifying the efforts made to give them education in statistical methods and applications, as well as the expense that governments and others have borne in making possible their participation.

The Fortieth Term will last from June 1, 1986 to March 1987. Instruction will be given, at various levels, by members of the Indian Statistical Institute, statistical officers of the Government of India, teachers from foreign universities and lecturers provided by the United Nations and the Specialized Agencies.

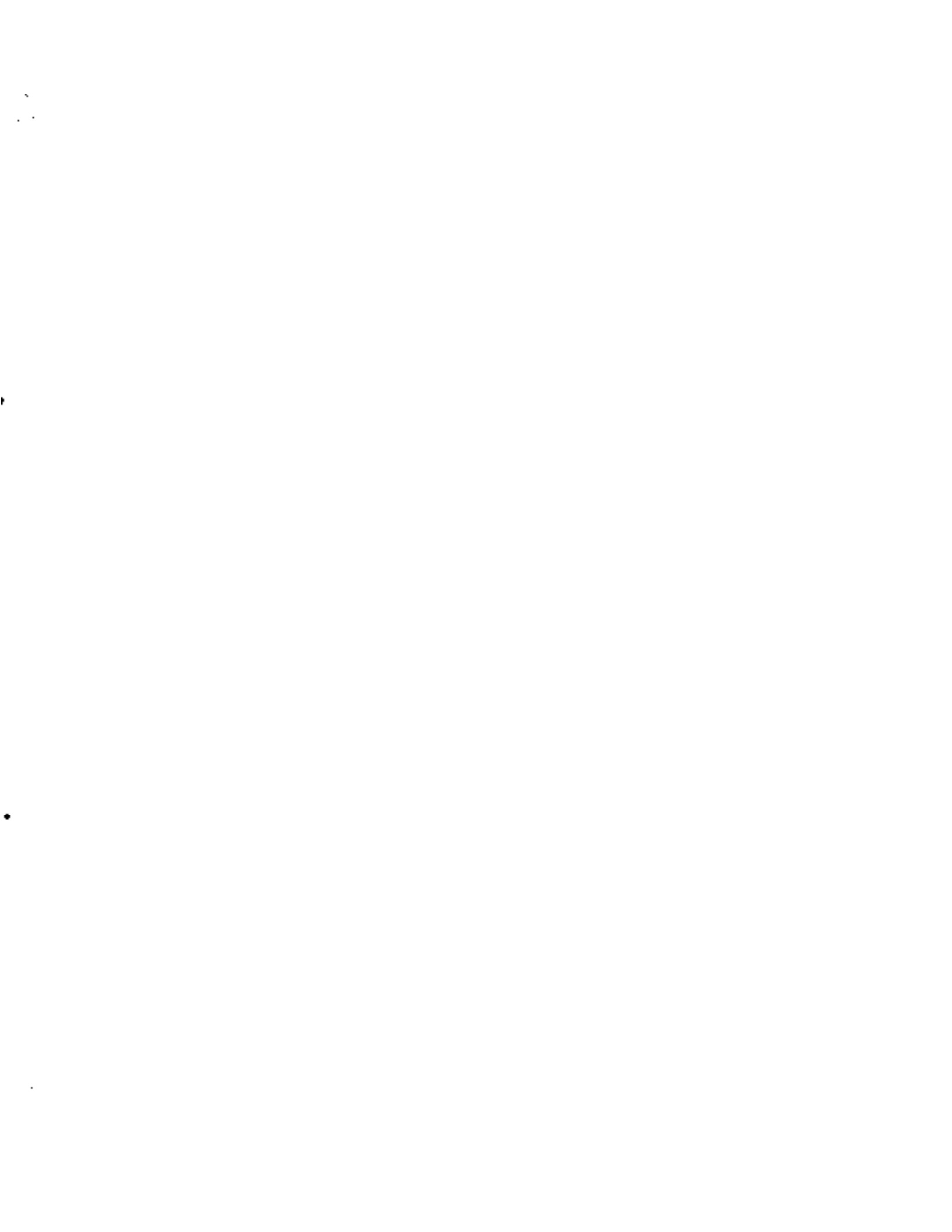
A prospectus on the International Statistical Education Centre, giving full details of the new Term, together with a specimen copy of the application form for admission to the Centre is enclosed.

Your country is invited to nominate participants in the course. Classroom, laboratory and field instruction is provided free of charge, but participants are expected to provide their travel, living and other expenses, presumably with the financial assistance of their Governments or other appropriate bodies.

In some countries a national committee has been set up to select qualified candidates for admission to the Centre. It would be highly appreciated if Your Government would establish such a committee, composed of e.g. two local representatives who would be available for informal consultation by the Director of Studies of the Centre. In this connection it is suggested that Your Government may nominate as local representatives (a) a professional statistician and (b) a prominent administrative officer. I should be grateful if Your Government would communicate the names and qualifications of these representatives to the Secretary of the Board of Directors of the Centre at Calcutta.

- (ii) the Director, Permanent Office, International Statistical Institute, 428 Prinses Beatrixlaan, 2270 AZ, Voorburg, Netherlands.

Applications for admission to the Regular Course (Fortieth Term) must reach the address in Calcutta not later than 31 December 1985.

Applications for admission to a Special Course should reach the above addresses at least five months in advance of the date from which the candidate proposes to start undergoing the course.

Note:

Application for all training grants should be taken up with the awarding authorities, by the sponsoring governments, separately from application for admission.

- (a) Government of India Colombo Plan and SQAP Training Grants. Application forms and information regarding the terms of the training grants and necessary assistance in forwarding the applications can be obtained from the Indian Mission in each country.
- (b) Training Grants from the Commonwealth Fund for Technical Cooperation (CFTC) Interested governments should contact CFTC, Commonwealth Secretariat, Marlborough House, Pall Mall, London SW1Y 5EE.
- (c) Applications for the Government of India training grants mentioned in section 1.3.6 of the Prospectus from countries not participating in the Colombo Plan Assistance Scheme or SQAP should be sent through the Indian Mission in the country and may be addressed to the concerned Ministry of the Government of India.
