3. Cash awards in the amount of Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000), Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000) and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000) shall be given to the first, second and third place winners, respectively. The cash prizes shall be utilized for further implementation of the program in the municipality/district/city.

4. Plaques of Merit for the regional director, regional and division coordinator-trainers, schools superintendent, district supervisor, governor/city mayor, municipal mayor, district coordinator- implementors of the national winner (first place) and certificates of merit for the same personnel of the second and third place winners will be presented on the regional and municipal levels where the program is being implemented.

5. Expenses incident to the presentation of the aforementioned awards, i.e., conduct of testimonial ceremonies and travel of personnel of the NFCS-DDB Special Project in Drug Abuse Prevention Education and of regional and division coordinators, are chargeable against project funds.

6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
