GRADE IV TEACHER FORMATION PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Chief of Service and Heads of Units/Centers  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. In line with the Ministry's efforts to upgrade the competencies of MECS field personnel and to ensure smooth and effective implementation of the New Elementary School Curriculum for Grade IV starting school year 1986-1987, the Grade IV Teacher Formation Program will be conducted at the different regional/division centers within the period November-December, 1985, January-February, 1986 and summer of same year. This program will be handled by the Regional/Division Subject Area Trainers and the PROED-ERP Regional Trainers.
2. All training sessions will be held for 10 days in a combined 4-day residential and 6-day non-residential program. Specific schedules for the different regions will be announced by the regional directors.
3. All teachers who are and will be teaching Grade IV are expected to attend this training program. Arrangements shall be made at the regional and sub-regional levels to ensure teacher availability.
4. The objectives of the program are as follows:
  - a. Develop in the participants personal and interpersonal skills necessary for effective teaching;
  - b. Orient teachers on their roles/responsibilities in PROED and in the total school system;
  - c. Equip teachers with instructional skills in the different learning areas; and
  - d. Clarify issues and problems related to the implementation of the NESC.
5. All teachers who complete the PROED-ERP will earn service credits in accordance with existing Ministry policies and procedures.
6. Expenses incident to this training program shall be charged against PROED-ERP funds, subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
