TRANSFER AND ORGANIZATION OF DECENTRALIZED
LEARNING RESOURCE CENTERS (DLRCs)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs, Elementary Education Division
Schools Superintendents

1. In line with the decentralization policy of this Ministry, regional directors are hereby authorized to approve requests for transfer of DLRCs as well as organization of new ones observing the following:

- a. Justifiable Reasons for the Transfer of a DLRC
 - (1) Inaccessibility of transportation in the original site
 - (2) Lack of trained staff to handle the work
 - (3) Urgency in the use of the DLRC space for classroom purposes
 - (4) No guarantee of security for the equipment, instructional materials and other resources

- b. Criteria for the Organization of Prospective DLRCs
 - (1) Located centrally in a cluster of schools which it shall serve
 - (2) Located in a disadvantaged area of the division/district
 - (3) Staffed with competent teachers in the basic learning areas including nonformal education
 - (4) Equipped with at least the minimum resource materials (Please see DLRC Handbook)

2. In both cases a recommendation from the schools superintendent confirming the center to be in such a state is needed.

3. Transfer of centers may be resorted to upon the recommendation of the Administrator of the relieved school and the acceptance of the relieving school. It is desired that the MECS Central Office, c/o the Physical Facilities Division, Bureau of Elementary Education be informed of such developments.
