 Quoted hereunder is a portion of a letter dated November 25, 1985, of the Director, Office of Compensation and Position Classification, for the information and guidance of the field:

"Under existing rules individual appointment on CS Form 33 in six (5) copies shall be prepared whenever there are chaptes in designation or salary.

"Since the upgrading of positions under Circular Letter No. 84-4 involves change in salary range and salary, a new appointment to the position has to be issued for the incumbent thereof to avail of the new higher salary."

2. The aforementioned Circular Letter No. 84-4 dated May 30, 1984, is on adjustments in salary arising from approved Equivalents Record Form reflected in duly post-audited Plantilla Allocation Lists. To avoid delay in payment of sclary differentials, all those entitled to ERF adjustments should be issued appointments, in accordance with the instruction above, furnishing IBM the usual copies.
