WCCI CONFERENCE-WORKSHOP ON VALUES EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. Pursuant to the thrust of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports on values education and cognizant of the pressing need of the times, the World Council for Curriculum and Instruction (WCCI), Philippine Chapter, in coordination with the Bureau of Higher Education, the Catholic Education Association of the Philippines (CEAP), and the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE), will conduct a conference-workshop on April 9-10, at Sta. Isabel College, Taft Avenue, Manila. The theme of the conference-workshop is "Empowering the Teacher: Maximizing Human Resources for Values Education".

2. The objectives of the conference-workshop are the following:

- a. To dialogue on areas of difficulties encountered in tapping resources for values education;
- b. To demonstrate samples of techniques for maximizing human resources in values education through infusion integration and direct teaching;
- c. To assist the teacher in preparing instructional materials including lesson plans in values education;
- d. To provide a venue for interchange of ideas on values education; and
- e. To establish permanent network groups in values education throughout the country.

3. The expected outputs are the following:

- a. Lesson Learning episodes, instructional materials in values education (individual)
- b. Directory of Human Resources in Values Education (group)

4. The participants to this conference-workshop are public and private school teachers/faculty and curriculum developers (all levels); chiefs and assistant chiefs of the Bureau of Higher Education; and regional chiefs of Higher Education Division, Secondary Education Division and Elementary Education Division.

5. The registration fee is P300.00 to cover expenses for handouts, lunch and snacks. Travel and other expenses incurred by government participants shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations. Travel and other expenses of participants from private colleges and universities shall be provided by their respective institutions.



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6. The tentative program of activities is inclosed.
7. Immediate dissemination and implementation of this Memorandum is desired.
