BOY SCOUT NATIONAL JAMBOREE

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines will sponsor the 8th National Jamboree on February 21-27, 1987, in Baguio City, to commemorate the BSC Founders' 50th Anniversary. The tentative program and schedule of activities are inclosed.

2. With the theme "Scouting ... Legacy of Our Founders", the Jamboree aims to provide opportunities for MECS officials involved in scouting and scouts who are currently registered, to display their skills in scoutcraft, the ability to mix with other scouts from other regions and from other countries, and to be self-reliant and useful.

3. In view of the significance of this Jamboree, all MECS officials involved in scouting, particularly those occupying positions in the regional and local councils, may attend. Travel expenses are subject to the availability of funds from their respective offices and the usual accounting and auditing regulations. Scouts who are currently registered are authorized to attend, however, they have to make up for their absences in classes.

4. Jamboree fee of P100, transportation and other incidental expenses of each participant, shall be borne by their respective regional and local councils. MECS officials other than those mentioned in paragraph 3 may attend the Jamboree on official time only.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.






