1987 NATIONAL SPECIAL OLYMPICS GAMES  
FOR THE MENTALLY RETARDED

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents

1. The Philippine Special Olympics Games Foundation, in cooperation with the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports and the Ministry of Social Services and Development as well as some selected prestigious civic organizations, hereby announces the 1987 Special Olympics Games for the Mentally Retarded to be held at the University of San Carlos, Cebu City on May 21-24.

2. This Ministry and the Ministry of Social Services and Development are given the responsibility of recruiting and preparing athletes and facilitating the conduct of training and games workshops for special olympics coaches and coordinators, at least two of which will be held in Iligan and Davao within the last two weeks of March in preparation for the forthcoming games. Furthermore, the regional and division offices in Cebu are enjoined to extend every support to the Special Olympics Games Steering Committee tasked with preparing for the four-day event.

3. Schools/Agencies with organized classes for the mentally retarded are allowed to send a minimum of "6-member team delegation (12 special athletes, 3 coach-chaperones, and one head) or any maximum number of delegation members provided the ratio of 1 coach-chaperon for every 4 athletes and one delegation head is maintained, and subject to the selection process of the National Participants Committee.

4. Official team delegations will be provided free interisland (sea and air) transportation to/from Cebu City, including board and lodging throughout the four-day event by the Philippine Special Olympics Games Foundation. The schools have to defray only the costs of their team's uniforms, associated land transportation and other incidental expenses, which can be charged against local funds, subject to the usual auditing procedures. Civic clubs in respective communities may be tapped for this purpose.

5. The regional supervisor in-charge of Special Education is urged to coordinate with the Office of the Regional Director, MESD.

6. Inclosed is the Games Plan from the sponsoring organization.
