HUMAN RIGHTS EDUCATION SEMINAR

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. A program seminar on the teaching of human rights in the three levels of education will be introduced in the different regions.
2. The human rights education program will be a five-day seminar divided into two parts. Part I, which will be for three days, covers human rights in general, principles and philosophy, the Human Rights provisions in the New Constitution, as well as legal rights of teachers. Part II, which is for two days, is devoted to leadership building.
3. The program is open to ACT and non-ACT members, and school administrators in both public and private schools. Participants attending this seminar shall be on official time and shall be given leave credits.
4. The program may be considered as a cognate course in graduate curricula in Education and the Social/Political Sciences, for which three units graduate credit may be granted to qualified participants who satisfactorily meet the requirements of the five-day seminar.
5. Human rights personalities and organizations will be invited to support the program where they could serve as resource persons or give support service to enhance both the formal and non-formal aspect of the program.
6. A nominal fee of P100.00 per day shall be charged to defray expenses for board, lodging and transport. Expenses incident to this program shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations. Private schools shall make their own arrangements regarding the expenses of their delegates.
7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
