1987 SUMMER DECS-BTVE AND NMVC VOCATIONAL TEACHERS TRAINING PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors  
 Regional Directors  
 Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
 Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. This Office wishes to announce that the National Manpower and Youth Council will conduct a skills upgrading program for vocational teachers and instructors on April 27-May 19 at the National Manpower and Youth Council National Skills Training Center, Taguig, Metro Manila and at two regional training centers at Talisay and at Davao. This 1987 Vocational Teachers Training Program is the first of a series of interventions to improve the vocational-technical sectors in cooperation with NMVC and industry's community.

2. The particulars of the courses to be offered are as follows:

3. These are the entry requirements:

- a. must be teaching for the current year and will be teaching in the coming school year in the trade area being applied for. Certification to this effect to be contained in the application form;
- b. must have permanent appointment as junior college instructor;
- c. must not be more than 50 years old on his latest birthday;
- d. recommendation from the school board and properly endorsed by the schools superintendent and/or regional director concerned, the recommendation to include a certification that local school funds are available to cover the training fee, monthly stipend, and travel expenses, food and housing accommodation and other authorizd allowances of the recommendee; and
- e. two copies of official Transcript of Records of the recommendee, three copies of each of the enclosed information sheet and Skills Training Credit Contract all properly duly signed should be attached to the letter of recommendation.

4. The Vocational Teachers Training Program shall cover skills upgrading, instructional methods, workshop management, trade testing, and related functional areas whenever necessary. A description of the courses may be found in Inclosure No. 4.

5. The local schools shall pay NMYC the training fee of each teacher-trainee the amount of which is stipulated in the column on courses/cost per trainee to cover cost of supplies and materials, power, depreciation, insurance, trade test and other administration costs. It shall also provide travelling expenses to the training center and return.


6. In coordination with STVE, the National Skills Training Center Regional Manpower Training Center will conduct the final evaluation of all recommendation to the courses applied for.

7. Considered applicants will be duly notified of their acceptance to the training program by the NMYC-NSTC, Taguig, Metro Manila before the training starts.

8. Application Forms should be received at NMYC, Taguig, on or before April 20, 1987. Those accepted will accomplish incl. No. 1, the information sheet and Incl. No. 2, skills training contract and Incl. No. 3, recommendation of the BCVS director or assistant director to be personally handed to the Director, Regional Training Center.

9. After the training program, the Director, through the Regional Ad Hoc committee shall submit reports to the Director, STVE on the implementation of the program emphasizing the problems encountered, recommendations and list of trainees indicating the course finished, number of training hours, station, address division and region for record purposes.







10. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.


