MANAGEMENT INSTITUTE ON PHYSICAL EDUCATION
AND SCHOOL SPORTS (MIPES)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
School Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. In compliance with the provisions of Article XIV, Section 19 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, mandating the promotion of physical education and school sports program to instill self discipline, teamwork and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizens, the Department through its Bureau of Physical Education and School Sports (BPESS) is conducting the first national Management Institute on Physical Education and School Sports on May 25-June 6, at Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
2. At the end of the institute, participants are expected to have attained the following:
 - a. Identified and critically appreciated the policies and programs adopted or planned on physical education and school sports program in developing countries;
 - b. Reviewed the national, regional, provincial/city school division and agency, institutional and administrative structures and changes for facilitating a genuinely participative approach to a mass-based physical education, physical fitness and school sports program;
 - c. Discussed/analyzed the efficacy of alternative models and strategies for improving the present physical education and school sports program at the elementary level;
 - d. Analyzed critically the use of recent techniques/innovative strategies, programs

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and provides for the training of valuers to assess physical education and school sports programs and projects;

- e. Augmented or refreshed knowledge on the methodologies of program, product formulation, management and evaluation used in specialist and general areas;
- f. Analyzed the parameters of innovative and successful action programs in physical education and school sports.

3. Participants to this Institute who shall be nominated in writing by their respective regional dimensions and schools superintendents shall include the following:

4. Program directors and school superintendents are enjoined to closely follow the criteria for the selection of nominees to this program as these are critical to the effective implementation of the PESE program in their respective region or school division. It is expected that the nominees shall be accountable to their respective heads in the 1987-1988 PESE program implementation hence no one shall be required to sign the service contract attached in the application form.

5. The Bureau of Physical Education and School Sports shall provide for the cost of the participants' board and lodging instructional materials and kits, uniform including payments of tuition fee and other miscellaneous fees for nine (9) academic units credit to the graduate/undergraduate Specialization in Physical Education at the Philippine Institute of Physical Education and Sports. Transportation and training allowances to participants shall, however, be chargeable against local/agency funds subject to the usual accounting and utilization rules of regulators. Transcription, honoraria or allowances of non-government persons, speakers and project staff shall be chargeable against the PESE funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. Only participants with application forms accomplished fully endorsed by their respective heads and received at the MIPESSE Secretariat, Bureau of Physical Education and School Sports on or before May 8, shall be authorized to participate in this Institute.

7. Inclosed are the tentative schedule of activities, list of speakers/resource speakers, and MIPESSE Form T-7 (nomination form) for the information and guidance of all concerned.

8. Widest publicity of this memorandum to all concerned is enjoined.


