TRAINING OF THIRD YEAR TRYOUT TEACHERS ON THE PROPOSED  
SECONDARY EDUCATION CURRICULUM

To: Regional Directors  
School Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. Tryout teachers for the third year level of the proposed secondary curriculum will participate in a live-in training program on the effective implementation of the curriculum and maximum utilization of instructional materials from May 13 to June 12, at Teachers Camp, Baguio City. The training is intended to upgrade the professional competencies of the teachers and orient them to the significant features of the proposed program. The training program has the following objectives:

- a. Develop the teacher's awareness of self as a person and as a teacher;
- b. Demonstrate skills and understanding of basic and effective communication;
- c. Gain knowledge and information on the present curriculum and trends in the Philippine secondary education;
- d. Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the objectives, the basic concepts and strategies of the proposed curriculum and the instructional materials to be used for its implementation;
- e. Devise instruments for effective evaluation of the curriculum; and
- f. Prepare other instructional materials for the effective implementation of the curriculum.

2. Teachers who have been recommended by the Regional Offices and who have been officially approved shall participate in the training. They are expected to register at the Teacher's Camp on May 13.

3. Tryout teachers from Regions 5-12 may get their plane tickets from the following PAA office:

4. Board, lodging and inland transportation expenses shall be charged to project funds.
