DECS MEMORANDUM

1987 EDUCATORS' CONGRESS

To: Undersecretaries  
Assistant Secretaries  
Bureau Directors/Regional Directors  
Heads of Agencies/Centers  
Heads of State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. A conference of school executives will be held in the Teachers Camp, Baguio City, on May 20-22 on the theme, "Equity and Quality in Education Towards National Unity and Progress".

2. The objectives of the Congress are as follows:

- a. To share experiences of public and private educational institutions/organizations in obtaining equity of access to quality education;
- b. To disseminate research findings relevant to equity of access to quality education;
- c. To derive models for systematizing approaches to equity in the distribution of resources and services through collaboration, partnership, linkages of government and non-government agencies;
- d. To develop a national program for achieving equity of access to quality education in collaboration and coordination with all educational institutions and agencies both public and private; and
- e. To update the field on latest policies, programs and projects, i.e. bilingual education, values education, nonformal education, religious instruction, etc.







3. All Departmental Vice Chairmen - Undersecretaries, assistant secretaries, bureau and assistant bureau directors, regional and assistant regional directors, schools and assistant schools superintendents, vocational schools superintendents, and chiefs of promotional divisions in the bureaus and regional offices - will attend the Conference. Likewise, school executives - presidents/heads of state and private colleges and universities/institutions - are authorized to attend the conference.

4. Professional organizations/heads of schools are encouraged to conduct mini-conferences on topics covered in the sessions before going to the Congress.

5. On fees and other expenses:

- a. The following conference fees of P1,200.00 for 4 days and P1,000.00 for 3 days which include board and lodging and conference materials will be charged each participant who will stay in the Camp.
- b. Participants who will not stay in the Camp will pay P500.00 to cover registration fees, cost of handbooks, lunch and snacks.
- c. All expenses, including transportation and conference fees, to be incurred by the delegates from DECS and government schools are chargeable against local funds, subject to the availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing procedures. Participants, therefore, shall not be entitled to per diems for the duration of the conference. The participants from the private institutions may have their own funding arrangements with their respective schools.
- d. Accommodations in the Teachers Camp will be limited to Congress participants. Participants who will be bringing their spouses or families should make arrangements for accommodations outside the Camp.
- e. To enable the camp management to have an estimate of the number attending the conference, regional treasurers and presidents of state colleges and universities and private schools are requested to submit to the Office of Undersecretary Mindra C. Sutaria, Chairman, Organizing







Committee, before May 10 the list of participants from their region, indicating the number, position and sex, e.g.
