NATIONAL DANCE EDUCATION WORKSHOP

To: Bureau Directors

1. In line with the cultural revival program of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, the Dance Education Association of the Philippines is sponsoring the Second National Dance Education Workshop to be held at the Philippine Normal College on May 14-17, 1987. Inclosed is the Program of Activities.

2. After the four-day workshop, the participants should be able to:

- a. explore and identify the possibilities of using dance as a medium in the development and formation of values;
- b. analyze techniques or strategies in composing and choreographing dances, with emphasis on creativity; and
- c. utilize the appropriate choreographic style in the creative presentation of folk dances, in order to make them more likeable and appreciated, but still retain the cultural and ethnic character inherent in the dances.

3. The participants are elementary school physical education teachers, secondary physical education/music teachers, college dance instructors, recreation leaders, physical education supervisors and coordinators.

4. Participants shall be allowed to attend on official time and may be given financial assistance from local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures. Registration fee is ₱200.00.

5. It is desired that this Memorandum be disseminated to all concerned.
