NATIONAL SEMINAR-CONFERENCE OF PHILIPPINE ELEMENTARY  
SCHOOL PRINCIPALS ASSOCIATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education, Department of Education, Culture and Sports, in coordination with the Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA) will hold a national seminar-conference at the Marston A. Quizon Elementary School in Malate, Manila from May 26 to 29, 1967. The theme is "Social Transformation through Value Reorientation for Unity, Peace and Progress."

2. The objectives of the seminar-conference are as follows:

- a. To revitalize value reorientations in principals for unity, peace and progress.
- b. To acquire deeper insights into various manifestations of values as a catalyst for social unification.
- c. To delineate the role of the principal in value reorientation for national stability.

3. Every school division is requested to send at least two delegates aside from one present outgoing PESPA officers and board members. Elementary principals from the private schools are also invited to attend. Each participant shall be charged a conference fee of P100.00 to cover seminar materials, lunch and snacks. The expenses may be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

4. It is desired that this memorandum be disseminated to all concerned.
