ANNUAL NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE DLRC ADMINISTRATORS

Regional DLRC Coordinators

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education is conducting the Annual National Conference of DLRC Administrators on the improvement of DLRCs and other school facilities at Las Brisas Resort Hotel, Antipolo, Rizal on June 22-26.
2. The expected output of the conference are guidelines on the effective management of DLRCs, a research proposal on the impact of DLRCs on pupil performance and an action plan on the management of DLRCs and meeting standards for school furniture and equipment.
3. The participants to the conference are the Chief of the regional office elementary education division, the regional DLRC coordinator and six members of the staff of the Bureau of Elementary Education, Central Office.
4. The participants are requested to bring with them a capsuleized report of DLRC accomplishments for the SY 1986-1987, copies of program of activities undertaken during their echo seminars, workshops, or conferences and a copy of the division and regional progress report on the acquisition of school furniture and equipment.
5. A bus will be hired to transport the participants to Las Brisas Resort Hotel, Antipolo, Rizal. Participants are requested to assemble at the Palacio del Gobernador at 8:00 a.m. on June 22. Departure will be at 8:30 a.m.
6. Travel and other expenses of the participants shall be charged against the BEE funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures.
7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to those concerned is desired.
