INFORMATION ON TASK FORCE TO INVESTIGATE THE ACTIVITIES
OF ALLEGED SATANIC GROUPS IN SCHOOL CAMPUSES

To: Regional Directors

School's Superintendents

Elementary, Junior Colleges, and the Committees

Heads of Private schools, Colleges and the Committees

of Catholic School Superintendents & Administrators

1. This Office has received several reports that certain groups of young people called "Satanic Groups" are roaming around Metro Manila and some urban centers in the country. These groups have reportedly succeeded in infiltrating the public schools in Manila. Some parts of Marikina and the Alabang - Cubao, Quezon City were also reported as their areas of operations.

2. The said groups are divided into three main "factions": "Explored", "Deviant Virtue", "Hazard", "Sexist", "Haters", and "Toxic Personnel". The distinguishing symbols of many members are Monroe-style hats like that of Mr. T of the Tanz TV series. They wear inverted crucifixes, and their slogan are "no government", and "no future". Some of the symbols they use are "Inventive", on the "Deviant Virtue", the "pertinent", the upside down "Satanicain", and one emblem on the "Hazard".

3. Members of the group perpetrate blasphemic writing, paperburn, murals or graffiti on trees in the area of Seven Seas angles are platforms to initiate new members. Group mates also indulge in brainwashing, cult abuse, terrorism, violence and crime of torture and mutilation of bodies.

4. The alarming and insidious activities of these groups in relation to the concern for safety of human lives, the dehumanizing effects on our youth require the alertness of school officials on the presence of these groups in their school campuses. In order to infiltrate in these groups, administrative offices should organize task forces to investigate the alleged
