STUDENT LOAN SLOTS FOR SY 1987-1988

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The National Scholarship and Student Loan Center, in coordination with the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS), Social Security System (SSS) and Land Bank of the Philippines (LBP), offers 2,225 slots for school year 1987-1988 to qualified applicants in the various projects of the program throughout the thirteen regions of the country.

2. The Screening Committees of all school divisions, state/private schools, colleges and universities and other involved agencies shall adhere to the guidelines in the selection of applicants contained in Rule V of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the SNPLP and follow the schedule of screening and processing of the applicants' papers for school year 1987-1988 (Inclosure No. 1). Likewise, the qualified applicants are requested to enrol in prescribed priority courses and accredited schools in the region where they come from (Inclosure No. 2).

3. SNPLP Regional coordinators shall meet and re-orient the division supervisor incharge of the student loan program to effect the necessary administration in the conduct of screening and processing of papers of the applicants which are the following:

a. Screening of applicants

Schools Division Supervisors shall pre-screen the applicants, rank them according to priority and only those who are qualified shall be allowed to fill up the coded application form. The Schools Division Supervisors shall likewise inform the applicants of their approved application.

b. Processing of application papers

The masterlist of selected SNPLP applicants with the application form (RSSIC Copy) and set of supporting documents shall be submitted to the Executive Director, National Scholarship and Student Loan Center, Department of Education, Culture and Sports, Arrocero Street, Manila on the following targetted schedule:

July 15, 1987	1st semester, SY 1987-1988
September 10, 1987	2nd semester, SY 1987-1988

The application form (Lending Institution Copy) of selected SMPLP applicants with another set of supporting documents and the original copies of Enrollment Certification and Statement of Accounts for the current year shall directly be submitted to the Main/Branch Offices of the lending institution to expedite release of educational loans.

4. All qualified applicants under the different projects of the program shall have a relative-guarantor who is either a GSIS or SSS member. The guarantor shall affix his/her signature in the coded application form (Lending Institution Copy) above his/her printed name indicating therein his/her residential address and GSIS/SSS Policy/Membership number before it shall be notarized.

5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

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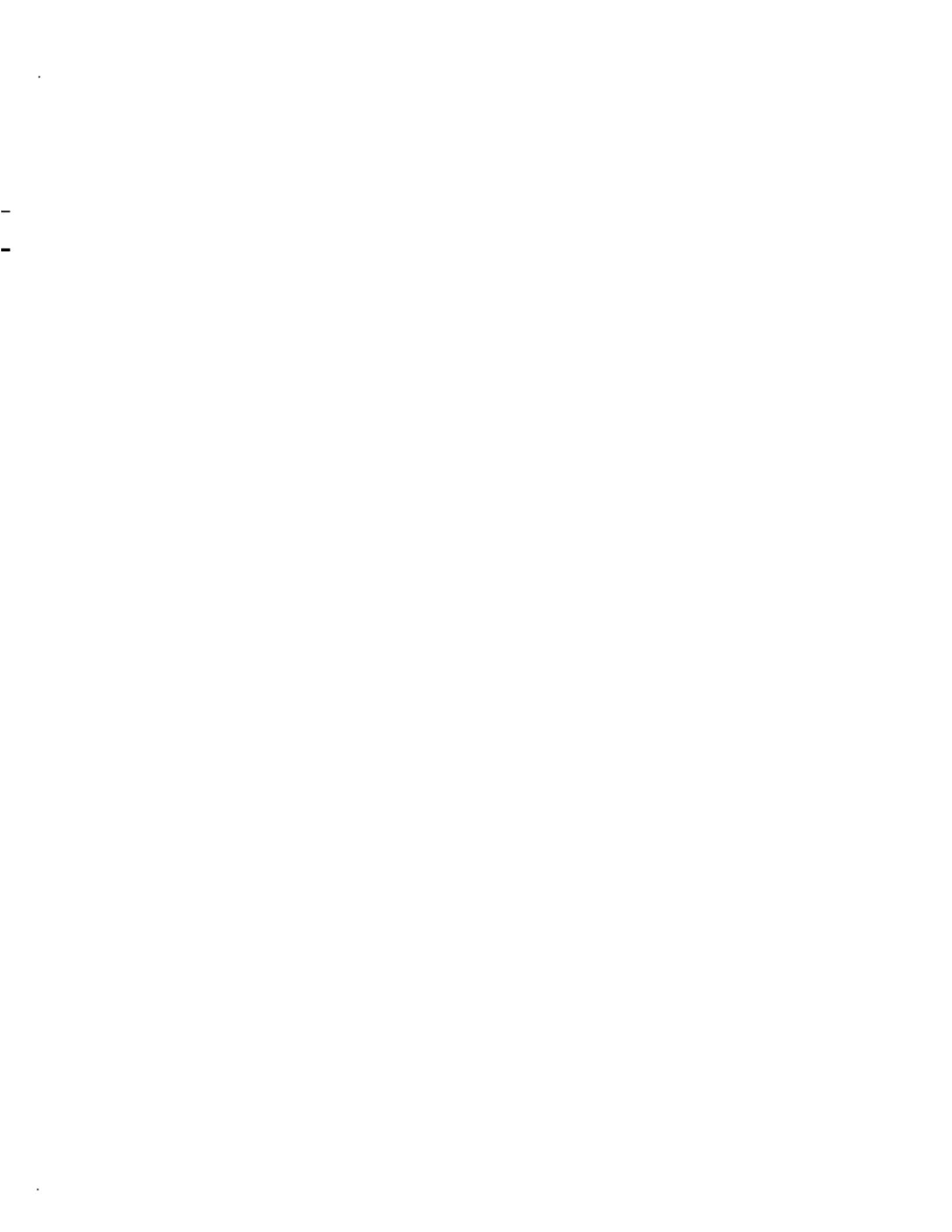
