PROPOSED POSTER DESIGN CONTEST TO CELEBRATE
THE 10TH ANNIVERSARY FOUNDATION OF THE ASES

1. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports, in collaboration with the Department of Foreign Affairs, is sponsoring an on-the-spot poster design contest to commemorate the 10th Anniversary Foundation of the ASES. The theme of the contest is "ASEAN FOR TODAY and TOMORROW".


2. The contest is open to all Filipino pupils and students regularly enrolled during the school year 1986-87 in all private and public elementary and secondary schools. It shall be conducted in five levels: (a) school, (b) district, (c) division, (d) regional and (e) national levels. Only one entrants declared first place winners at the lower level (area), shall qualify to compete in the next higher level. Hence, only first place winners in the regional level for the elementary and the secondary category shall compete in the national level. Inclosed are the rules of the contest.

3. The contest in each level can be conducted in any day within the following schedule:

School Level Contest	July 1-6
District Level Contest	July 7-13
Division Level Contest	July 14-21
Regional Level Contest	July 22-25
National Level Contest	July 26
Awarding of National Winners	August 7

4. The prizes and awards are as follows:

- a. High School Category
- First Prize - Trophy plus cash award
 - Second Prize - Trophy plus cash award
 - Third Prize - Trophy plus cash award



b. Prizeberry Category

First Prize - Trophy plus cash award
Second Prize - Trophy plus cash award
Third Prize - Trophy plus cash award

b. The logo of the winning entry in the national level contest shall be the official poster of the ASEAN Summit Conference in December. It will be reproduced and distributed to display in schools and systematically located hotels, restaurants and other suitable establishments in the country as well as in other ASEAN countries.

c. It is requested that the media be given adequate publicity to ensure more participation.

NATIONAL POSTER DESIGN CONTEST RULES

1. The contestants shall be citizens of the United States and citizens regularly enrolled during the school year 1987-88 in all private and public elementary and secondary schools.
2. The contest shall be conducted on five levels: school, district, division, regional and national levels. It shall be an open-poster drawing contest.
3. The poster shall be rendered in any technique (no size or format) using any medium of the contestant's choice such as water color, oil paint, charcoal, pencil, etc. All the required materials shall be provided by the contestants.
4. The poster-contest shall be conducted for three hours. The theme and title shall be determined by the school, district, division, regional and national contest committee.
5. The entries shall be judged under the following criteriat:
 - a. Relevance of the content to the theme
 - b. Artistry of execution
 - c. Originality
6. The entries declared first prize winners in the elementary and secondary category at the school level shall compete in the district levels. In the other hand, the first prize winners in the district level shall compete in the division level. As the regional level, only the entries declared first prize winners as the division level shall be considered in the selection of the official entry of the region in the national level. Contest for the elementary and secondary category.
7. The contest committee for each level shall choose the member of the Board of Judges, to be headed by a representative from DEGB.
8. The pupils and students whose entries have qualified for the regional contest in the elementary and secondary category shall be asked to render an open-poster drawing for another poster for three hours before the selection of the winning entries at the regional level. The contestants may either withdraw their entry or submit a new one.
9. In the selection of the winners in the regional level to each category, the Board of Judges should consider the posters made by the contestants in the open-poster drawing sessions at the regional level.

10. The representative of DDCS Central Office shall be the Chairman of the Board of Judges in the regional level. The Board may adopt other rules and criteria in addition to those observed at the division or district levels.
11. The representative of each Regional Office shall provide the art materials needed in the regional design and poster drawing sessions. He will be responsible for bringing the winning entries from each category in Region to the national level contests.
12. The Chairman of the Judging Committee shall inform the winners in the national level through the Regional Directors and the Superintendent, or by means of the facilities available for communication. All the winners in the national level are requested to attend the awarding ceremonies on August 8, 1981.
13. All winning entries in each category in the national level contest shall become the property of the National Poster Design Contest Committee, DDCS.
14. Representatives from the National Poster Design Committee shall oversee the conduct of the judging in the regional level.
