ENCOURAGING MORE MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS
ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES

1. The United Nations Association of the Philippines (UNAP), a national civic, non-sectarian and non-partisan organization was established in 1947 to help actualize the ideals of the United Nations in the maintenance of peace at all times and strive to promote world understanding, cooperation and peace among nations based on human dignity and universal friendship.
2. The main purpose of the UNAP is to promote better understanding and appreciation of the United Nations activities in the maintenance of peace and security, in the acceleration of economic and social development, promotion of cultural heritage, human rights and harmonious relations among nations of the world and strive to involve the Filipino people in the attainment of these goals.
3. To achieve these ends, the UNAP initiates a year-round continuing program of activities responsive to the needs of national development as well as national progress in consultation with the United Nations Information Centre for the Philippines and in collaboration with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the DECS.
4. It also provides appropriate media for the dissemination of information about the workings of the United Nations designed to enhance inter-cultural understanding within the country as well as international understandings, cooperation and peace through the annual celebration of United Nations Week.
5. Cognizant of the fact that the Philippines was one of the signatories to the United Nations Charter in 1946 represented by the late General Carlos E. Romulo, and believing in the propagation of the UN ideals, principles and objectives, this Office is urging more individuals, schools, colleges and universities to become members of the UNAP.
6. In accordance with the By-Laws of the Association membership fees shall be payable upon submission of the membership application, heretofore attached.
7. Annual dues shall be payable at the beginning of each fiscal year but not later than January 31st.
