ORIENTATION SEMINAR OF TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL SCHOOL TRADES
IN REGIONS I TO XII AND MCR

To: Bureau Directors

Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators
Technical-Vocational School Principals

1. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports through the Bureau of Technical and Vocational Education and the Tech-Voc regional ad hoc committee will conduct a series of orientation-seminars on the three (3) technology courses of the post-secondary non-degree curricular offerings in Trades, Home Industries and Non-Traditional courses as follows:



2. The objective of the seminar is to orient the heads of schools on the policies, minimum standards, guidelines and other pertinent information regarding the three (3) new post-secondary technology courses recently developed by the Bureau of Technical and Vocational Education in consultation with the private sector.

3. Heads of public and private technical-vocational schools are encouraged to attend the orientation-seminar-workshop including the chairman and members of the regional Tech-Voc ad-hoc committees in the 13 regions all over the country.

4. A registration fee of Four Hundred Pesos (P400.00) will be charged each participant except ad hoc committee members to cover the cost of seminar materials and other miscellaneous expenses. Travelling expenses of school heads will be charged against local funds. Board and lodging of ad hoc committee members will be provided by the BTVE while except transportation from their respective stations while BTVE staff travelling expenses will be charged from PTVF funds, all subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

5. All heads (Home Industries Training Supervisor) of Home Industry/Craftsmen schools from Ilocos are requested to attend the workshop at MISI, Marikina while Visayas and Mindanao will attend at Cebu City.



6. Inclosure No. 1 is the tentative program of activities for the two-day seminar, inclosure No. 2 is the executive and working committees and inclosure No. 3 is the ad hoc committee for the information and guidance of participants.

7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
