SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON THE TERTIARY LANGUAGE CURRICULUM

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chief of Service and Heads of Units/Centers
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools/Colleges and Universities

1. The Philippine Association for Language Teaching, Inc., in coordination with the Bureau of Higher Education, Department of Education, Culture and Sports will hold a seminar-workshop on the tertiary language curriculum on August 27-29 at the Benitez Hall, College of Education, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City.
2. The seminar-workshop aims to gear the tertiary curriculum on language teaching to the 1987 National Bilingual Policy.
3. All tertiary institutions are encouraged to send two delegates (one representing English, another representing Filipino) from any of the College of Education, College of Arts and Letters, College of Arts and Sciences. The Higher Education Division of each regional office and the Bureau of Higher Education may likewise send their representatives.
4. A registration fee of P450.00 to cover snacks, lunches and conference materials will be charged each participant. Transportation, per diem and other allowable expenses of those coming from government institutions may be charged against Local Funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing regulations. Participants from private institutions shall make their own financial arrangement with their respective institutions.
5. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is desired.
