NOMINEES FOR SCHOLARSHIPS, FELLOWSHIPS, TRAINING
AND STUDY GRANTS ABROAD

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. Pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 29 of the Civil Service Commission and in the interest and welfare of those in the career civil service, all nominees for scholarships, fellowships, training and study grants abroad shall be only those with permanent appointments. This is also one of the criteria for the selection of candidates for foreign scholarships of the KALA Special Committee on Scholarships.
2. As a matter of policy, these opportunities should be widely distributed. Hence, preference should be given to those who have not had any training abroad so far.
3. It is desired that there be an increasingly more systematic coordination of our program of study abroad for which purpose all nominations should continue to be submitted for processing and action to the Secretariat for International Education Matters, Department of Education, Culture and Sports.
