INAUGURAL CONGRESS OF THE SOUTHEAST ASIA-PACIFIC  
REGION OF THE INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY  
FOR EDUCATION THROUGH ART (INSEA)

1. The Philippines will host the Inaugural Congress of the Southeast Asia-Pacific Region of the International Society for Education Through Art (INSEA) on December 13-20, 1987 at the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP).
2. The general objective of the Congress is to develop the art consciousness of the youth. "Art Education and Cultural Evolution" has been chosen as the theme of the congress. The activities on the first three days consist of plenary sessions at the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP) in the morning and interaction tours in the afternoon. The next four days will take the delegates to a rolling congress in the Ilocos Region for a glimpse of the Philippine culture.
3. In view of this rare opportunity to have this kind of educational activity in the country, art teachers, coordinators, and supervisors are encouraged to attend the congress on official time. Relatedly, the schools in Manila are enjoined to participate in the Children's Art Exhibition for Manila Elementary Schools Center for the Art (MESCART) in Puerto Real on December 15 at 2:00-5:00 in the afternoon. The exhibit will showcase children's art and crafts.
4. The INSEA has announced that the following fees will be collected from the local participants:
