FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE COUNCIL
OF DEPARTMENT CHAIRMEN FOR ENGLISH

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Council of Department Chairmen for English (CDCE), in cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports through the Bureau of Higher Education, is conducting the Fifth General Assembly to be held at the Technological University of the Philippines, Taft Avenue, Manila, on September 24-25,

2. The theme of this assembly's symposium forum is "Gearing English Curriculum and Instruction to Human Resource Development."

3. The participants to this affair will be the Deans of Arts and Sciences and Heads/Chairmen of the English Departments of colleges and universities.

4. The objectives of the Assembly are:

- a. to heighten college English teachers' competence to gear English teaching to human resource development;
- b. to make teachers appreciate the continuum in teaching English for human resource development from basic education to tertiary level; and
- c. to identify the areas of curriculum and instruction which conduce to teaching for human resource development and demonstrate the techniques and strategies that will help achieve the objective.

5. The registration fee per delegate is ₱200.00 to cover snacks and lunches for two days, handouts and certificate of participation. Expenses incurred by participants from the state colleges and universities will be chargeable against their local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures; while those from private schools will have to make arrangements with their respective schools.

6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
