1987 NURSES WEEK CELEBRATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Philippine Nurses' Association will celebrate its 30th Nurses' Week and 55th Foundation Anniversary in Manila on October 26-29, 1987. The theme of the convention is "Face: A Continuing Quest."
2. This year's celebration shall highlight the nurses' social responsibility for health and health education as well as update the nurses on current issues and problems.
3. Attendance at the convention shall be considered as fulfilling the contact hours for Continuing Professional Education (CPE) units, a requirement for renewal of licenses to practice nursing.
4. In view of the benefits that the nurses may derive from this convention, school administrators are requested to encourage the public health nurses under their jurisdiction to attend the convention on official time only. Registration fees may be reimbursed by local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to the nurses is desired.
