**COOPERATIVE REGIONAL CONSULTATIONS, ACADEMIC FIELDING
AND NATIONAL CONFERENCE**

1. Background/Reasons

1.1 In recognition of the role of private education in an integrated system of education and its vital role by contribution to national development, a Task Force to study Private Higher Education was created on November 21, 1977. Among the functions of the Task Force is to analyze the status and performance of private higher education, its role and its relevance to the needs of the people and society.

1.2 The Task Force completed and submitted its recommendation to the opportunity of presented by the new Constitution which provide enabling educational legislation.

2. The COOPERA Project

2.1 The Coordinating Project for Private Educational Associations (COOPERA) through a grant from the Ford Foundation to Private Education (FAPED) will implement a project to augment the efforts of the DECS in educational legislation.

2.2 The COOPERA Educational Legislative Project has the following objectives:

2.2.1 Encourage educational and other sectoral representatives to work jointly under one umbrella improving the respective educational legislative concerns and priorities.

2.2.2 Promote an intersectorally, inter-regional forum as free as possible from the constraints of those educational legislative outcomes.

2.2.3 Submit annually an draft bill or resolution to the PHL Law Office or Congressional Delegation.

2.2.6 Encourage educational associations and other groups to closely monitor Congressional action on proposed educational legislation.

2.3 The Project will consist of three main activities:

2.3.1 Regional Consultations: A process through which the Program Coordinator will elicit from the various sectors within the region they concern on educational legislation. The consultations will also provide an avenue hearings on the draft bills prepared by the PSE Law Office Committee.

2.3.2 Area Conferences - The contingently located regions have been broken into areas. Regions I-VI, including NCR comprise one area. Regions VII-VIII comprise another area and Regions IX-XII, the Mindanao area. The conferences are intended to consolidate the concerns of the regions within an area.

2.3.3 National Congress - the culminating activity for the series of consultative and area meetings during which the legislative agenda of the public and private education system would be presented to the CEDS Secretary and the members of the Education Committee of Congress.

2.4 Schedule of Activities

2.4.1 Regional Consultations - August through September. The Regional Coordinators will inform the Department and its Regional Offices of the dates and venue of the consultation meetings in their respective regions.

2.4.2 Area Conference - Region I, including NCR - August 24, 1987, Centro Escolar University, Manila

Region VI-VII - Technological University of San Carlos, Cebu City

Regions IX-XII - University of Holy Cross, Davao City

2.4.3 National Congress - October 5, 1987, University of Santo Tomas, Manila

3. DECB Participation
