OFFICIAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP FOR GENERAL EDUCATION SUPERINTENDENTS
CENTRAL & FIELD HEALTH INSPECTORS

THE REFORMED DIRECTORATE
GENERAL GOVERNMENT

1. In an effort to effectively implement the policy on health education and health care services to the total population, a designated program for the implementation of the School Health Education Program has been developed by the School Health and Nutrition Division (SHND), DEDB, Manila.

2. The objective is to mainstream health education and alternative system to effectively implement the School Health and Nutrition Program as proposed by DEDB. It will start at Level 1 and upgrade the professional competence of the health services providers. At the same time, it will supervisory and supportive roles. The General Education Division (GED) shall facilitate the training in the various areas of responsibility in turn shall be responsible for the training of teachers as School Health Educators.

3. The approach is anticipated to be fully implemented in regions where the SHD (Health) staff have been trained. It shall consist of 3 levels of training:

LEVEL 1 - Training of SHD (Health)

LEVEL 2 - Training of Public Health Nurses as Trainers
of Teachers in SHD

LEVEL 3 - Training of Teachers as School Health Educators

4. Phase "A" of Level 1 Training is to be conducted in conjunction with GED (Health) from September 11, 1977, to November 17, 1977 and NCPD or Province/Dependencia level. It will be conducted by the School Health and Nutrition Center in collaboration with the DCEC, College of Education, and the DEDB. Training of teachers in the Department of Health Education, DEDB, College of Education, Manila, Class 11 of Level 1 training, may commence with the scheduling of a later date.

5. The fiscalizational aspect of the training shall be conducted for 3 weeks by the University of the Philippines,

b. Items, Outer City, will the practical aspects which is an integral part of the workshop shall be considered for the local DDC's participation division(s) in here she is assigned.

c. Participants are requested to arrive a day earlier. The start of the seminar workshop arrangements will begin nine hours before the inauguration at 0800 hrs at the DDC's conference hall. Individual fee for training shall be borne by the Schools that is, and Nutrition Center. Transportation expenses of the participants from other regions/divisions to the venue of the training program shall be charged against local funds available to the usual accounting and auditing procedure.

d. Schools of health and administration are requested to take their wholehearted support in the implementation of the school health training Program.

e. Simultaneous dissemination of the memorandum to all concerned is desired.
