SUBJECT: 8TH NATIONAL JAMBOREE (VISAYAS)

1. We are pleased to announce the conduct of the 8th National Jamboree in Visayas to be held on October 3-9, 1987 at Cadagnayan Norte, Sta. Barbara, Iloilo. Sta. Barbara is 15 kms. away from the city of Iloilo passing the newly constructed highway for ten (10) to fifteen (15) minutes ride.
2. The theme of this national activity is "SCOUTING... A LEGACY OF OUR FATHERS" in consonance with the BSP Founder's 5th Anniversary.
3. The expected attendance to this event is some 15,000 Scouts and Scouters from the 13 Councils in the Visayas Region and participants from the Mindanao and Luzon Regions as well as the Asia-Pacific Region.
4. Participants must have the following qualifications:

- Scouts: - currently registered with the BSP
- 12-17½ years old
- at least Scout Skills Badge Holder
- physically fit
- with sufficient long-term camping experience
- Scouters: - currently registered with the BSP
- 16 years old and above
- at least Prince of Adventure (PA)
- at least 2 years with leadership experience
- with sufficient long-term camping experience

5. A Jamboree fee of PWE-HIRED (\$100.00) PESOS shall be charged each participant (Local Scouts/Scouters) to cover cost of souvenir items, certificates, program materials and camp administration. TWENTY-FIVE (\$25.00) PESOS of the Jamboree fee must be submitted as reservation fee through the Visayas Regional Coordinating Center, Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Iloilo City not later than 15 September 1987 to aid the host Region/Council in determining the allocation of campsite, facilities, souvenir items and the necessary logistics. Balance of site, local participants shall provide their own tentage and food provisions for the duration of the Jamboree.
