SCHEDULE FOR THE FIFTH NATIONAL MEDICAL ADMISSION TEST (NMAT)

- 1. To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, Board College and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Deans of Medical Schools
- 2. The National Medical Admission Test (NMAT) for prospective applicants for admission into the various medical schools in the Philippines, will be administered by the Center for Educational Measurement (CEM) on December 5, 1987 in 10 (10) Testing Centers in the cities of Manila, Baguio, Cag., Mis., Cagayan de Oro and Davao.
- 3. Filing of applications will be from August 17 to October 16, 1987 for applicants taking the test in the above mentioned testing centers. Registration application forms may be obtained at the following places:

- 4. All applications shall be at the office of the Center for Educational Measurement (CEM) Makati, Metro Manila, on or before October 16, 1987. Late applications will not be entertained.

a. For applicants abroad, the NMAT will be administered in San Francisco and New York on 22-A. or October 6, 1987 and in Bangkok, Thailand on November 6, 1987. Test schedules/invitation forms in English copy may be obtained from their respective embassies or at the Philippine Consulate Office.

b. As a reminder to paragraph a, center (b) of DECIB under No. 49, s. 1987, the Board of Medical Education (BME) has it so that examinees can be allowed to take the NMAT only three (3) times. The countdown on the number of failures starts from the April 6, 1987 NMAT.

c. No student shall be granted the requisite certificate of Eligibility for Medicine (CEM), or admitted for enrollment as first year students in any medical college/university having qualified in the National Medical Admission Test (NMAT).

d. To avoid any semblance of bias and tampered NMAT scores by applicants, all DECIB Regional Offices are hereby instructed to verify their NMAT score in the master list provided by the Center for Educational Measurement before issuing the Certificate of Eligibility for Medicine to them. Medical school authorities are likewise instructed to take the same precautionary measure before enrolling students and to report immediately to this office any anomaly pertaining thereto.

e. The cut-off scores for this tenth national Medical Admission Test shall be determined and announced later by the Board of Medical Education.
