CELEBRATION OF MUSEUM WEEK '87

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 913, issued in 1971, the week from October 1 to 7 of every year has been designated as National Museum Week, a nationwide celebration. The proclamation aims to focus public attention to the National Museum and to all other public and private museums in the country.

2. Inclosed is the program of activities of the National Museum located at the Executive Bldg., Padre Burgos St., Manila.

3. The important role of museums in stirring national consciousness and developing pride among our people in their cultural and natural heritage, as well as in instilling cultural values, such as nationalism, unity and understanding among the diverse ethnic groups in our country, should be inculcated in the minds of everybody, especially the students. Lessons in Philippine culture, including visits to the National Museum or any other museum in the area/region, should be encouraged in relevant subjects at all educational levels. October 7, Saturday, has been designated as special day of guided tours for DECS officials and teachers.

4. All schools are enjoined to participate in the nationwide observance of Museum Week with a cultural program featuring native dances, songs, poems, stories, plays and the like, especially those indigenous to their area/region. The community and the school can thus cooperatively enhance their local culture, re-orient and re-direct cultural values of the youth, and preserve/promote Philippine culture.
