With the signing of Executive Order No. 92 by President Corazon C. Aquino, membership with the Fund has been voluntary. Therefore, members can choose DIFC personnel whether to continue or discontinue employment effective January 1987.

In this regard, please be informed of the following section provisions of the Implementing Rules and Regulations approved by the Board:

Rule III Section 2

A member covered by mandatory provisions of P.D. 1732 who opt to discontinue his contributions after December 31, 1986 shall advise the Fund in writing what he intends to do so, provided however, that he has no outstanding obligation to stand under any of its loan program. A member who fails to discontinue may subsequently be allowed to reactivate his membership by paying the required monthly contributions effective on the month of resumption and every month thereafter, without being required to pay contributions for the period of inactivity.

Rule IV Section 6

A member who has an existing loan under any of the Fund's loan program shall continue to remit the required contributions (which include the original counterpart) in accordance with the date herein specified until the loan has been fully settled and satisfied.

In view of these, it is proposed that the following procedures be followed to effect discontinuity/resumption of mandatory contributions of member with centralized payroll:

- a. DIFC sends letters monthly to informance of requiring resumption of membership from Payrolling Members.



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2. If yes/yes, whether member has existing loan with the Fund.
3. Prepares/Submit to DECS-IDB list of members for discontinuance.
4. IDB effects discontinuance/termination of deductions.
