DISSEMINATION OF THE DEPARTMENT'S POSITION ON THE CRIMES
BROUGHT ABOUT BY THE ABURTO MUTINY ON AUGUST 20, 1987

1. In order that all DROS personnel, teachers and students are properly informed about the official position of the Department in relation to the civil mutiny initiated by the renegade Mutiny of a disgruntled group in the military, it is desired that all Unit Head (e.g. a). Lewis take the responsibility of disseminating the statement of position (set reverse side) among their personnel. In the case of school heads, it would be desirable to disseminate the same, through teachers, staff and students with a view to ensuring understanding and appreciation of their respective roles in ensuring peace and stability.
2. It is important that officials of the constituency of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports are able to harmoniously work together so they will stand on issues such as this and on matters that will arise from time to time.

The Department of Education, Culture and Sports is committed to values education as the foundation of all education and the instrument of social transformation and national reconstruction. In these critical times, there is no role more important for DECS than to educate our citizenry on the need to uphold our national values threatened by the recent mutiny attempt.

The crisis is not over. Returning to normalcy and condemning the mutiny will not attack the roots of the crisis. There will be a need to address grievances, improve soldiers' welfare and bring about unity and cooperation between military and the civil government. Condemning the uprising and imposing swift, just and firm sanctions will not be enough, although it will be necessary.

The nation and its citizens must not be distracted from the basic points they must declare firmly and with one voice: No matter how just the grievances, whatever the persons, no matter what the issues, we must condemn any person -- military or civilian, with the government or against it -- who attempts a change of persons, policies or governments by means of violence rather than by peace, by means of dictatorial might rather than by democratic processes, and by means of brute power rather than by law.

Upholding, peaceful and democratic processes, respect for the law must be the cornerstones upon which to build an appreciation for and commitment to the human and democratic rights and values that all Filipinos should live and die for.
