CONSULTATIVE MEETING IN THE CAREER NEEDS
AND PROBLEMS IN HOME ECONOMICS

Offering Home Economics Education

1. The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA), in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold a consultative meeting on the needs and problems of Home Economics education for Home Economics educators, school administrators and supervisors of Home Economics programs. The meeting will be held at the U.P. Alumni Center, U.P. Diliman, Quezon City on November 12-13, 1987.
2. With the theme, "Integrating Findings on Achieve Home Economics Goals", the meeting is designed to meet the professional needs of Home Economics faculty members/teachers who will be teaching Home Management and Technology in the new Secondary Curriculum and Home Economics and Livelihood Education in the new Elementary School Curriculum required in the proposed curriculum for the Bachelor of Elementary Education and Bachelor of Elementary Education, respectively. This will equip them with increased knowledge and skills on the latest trends in Home Economics education.
3. In view of the anticipated benefits from the conference, this Office encourages Home Economics supervisors at the elementary, secondary and tertiary levels to avail themselves of the program on official time.
4. To facilitate the attendance of participants, it is requested that participants prepare a report on the division's/region's activities, needs and problems.
5. A seminar fee of P200 for each participant shall be charged to cover expenses for meals and hotels for the two-day conference.

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5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this program to all concerned is desired.
