Offering Home Economics Education

1. The Council on Deans and Heads of Home Economics of the Philippines (CUDHHEP), in coordination with the Bureau of Higher Education (BHE), Department of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold its National Conference-Workshop on October 22-24, 1987 at the Perpetual Help College, Biñan, Laguna. Enclosed is the tentative program of activities.
2. With the theme "Home Economics and Poverty", the workshop is designed to: (a) analyze household levels of poverty at urban and rural areas; (b) develop some appropriate Home Economics strategies for a. in reducing poverty, and (c) plan for a continuing institution of Home Economics strategies in response to the demand of the academe.
3. Participants to this conference-workshop are the Deans and Heads of Home Economics, college administrators, and selected teachers in Home Economics.
4. Registration fee of P120.00 per participant will be charged to cover expenses for honoraria, lectures, fellowship lunch and certificate of participation. Expenses incident on this program shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations. Private schools shall make their own arrangements regarding the expenses of their delegates. Arrangements for board and lodging for those who prefer to stay in the campus may be made separately with the Perpetual College Administration.
5. In view of the anticipated benefits from this seminar, this Office encourages all Home Economics deans, department heads and faculty members/H-EI teachers in the elementary, secondary and tertiary levels to avail themselves of the program.
