1988 INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S ART EXHIBITION

To: Undersecretaries,
Assistant Secretaries,
Bureau Directors,
Regional Directors,

Chief of Service and Heads of Divisions/Offices,
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities,
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. Every year, the Japan Collection Network Cultural Society and the Foundation for Art Education of Japan conduct an international children's art exhibition. In last year's exhibition, the Philippines submitted 1,128 entries and won 113 awards.

2. An invitation to participate in the 1988 International Children's Art Exhibition (1988) has been issued by the organizers.

3. Guidelines for participation are as follows:

- a. Subject: The choice of subject is free, but it must be the child's original work.
- b. No. of entries: Only 1 work may be submitted by the child.
- c. Age limit: Children's ages should not be less than 3 years and not more than 15 years on January 1, 1988.
- d. Size of works: The size of paintings/drawings shall not exceed 38 cm. x 34 cm. and preferably not less than 24 cm. x 36 cm.
- e. The following information must be attached to the reverse side of each painting/drawing:
 - * Full Name
 - * Title of Painting/
Drawing
 - * Sex
 - * Age
 - * Nationality
 - * Address of School

Medium: Any art medium is allowed but crayons or water colors are encouraged.

4. By way of ensuring the quality of the art works, the DECS regional offices are requested to coordinate the conduct of children's painting contests and to send only the best 20 art works to: Department of Education, Culture and Sports, Attention: The Director, Bureau of Elementary Education, DECS, Intramuros, Manila, not later than October 30, 1967 for transmittal to the Japanese organizers.
