SOCIAL JUSTICE AND HUMAN RIGHTS AT THE TERTIARY LEVEL

1. To review direction, policies, and programs of the Department of Education and Culture and the Department of Justice on the promotion of human rights at the tertiary level.
2. In view of the recent incidents of extrajudicial killings in the vicinity of the University of Mindanao and Davao City on October 1987, and to look into the conduct of government law enforcement agencies in the handling of extrajudicial killings, particularly those committed by the Association of Islamic Colleges in Asia and Islamic Countries for Cooperation (AICCI), PASEC and the Agency of Higher Education, in conducting a seminar on Human Rights and Human Dignity on October 26-28, 1987 at the Islamic Center - Hotel, Davao City, the Department of Education and Culture, Department of Justice, and the Department of Education and Culture, Davao City.
3. The seminar workshop is designed to respond to the call of Human Right Education at the tertiary level, and the following objectives:
- a. To review the human rights programs of the PDEA, Davao City, and the Department of Education and Culture in the implementation of the Human Rights and Human Dignity Program.
 - b. To know what social justice, respect for human rights, and sustainable development, as enshrined in the just and humane society and total human development can do toward the attainment of the goal of education.
 - c. To establish a mechanism for the exchange of human rights information between the tertiary education institutions.
 - d. To assess the situation in the field of human rights and human dignity in the field of science, technology, and education.

2. The participants are school administrators, senior and junior faculty, DECS officials from both central and regional offices, university educational researchers from the Higher Education Division.

3. Registration fee per participant is P600.00 (including snacks, lunches and handouts) or P120.00 (excluding snacks and lunches). Transportation, per diem and other allowable expenses of participants from government institutions shall be charged against local funds subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures. Participants from the private institutions shall make their own arrangements with their respective schools.

4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
