SOCIAL JUSTICE AND HUMAN RIGHTS AT THE TERTIARY LEVEL

For Bureau Director

1. In response to the incident involving Executive Order No. 127 mandating the inclusion of the study of human rights in the curricula of all levels of education and DECS Order No. 100-10-1987 which took effect on October 20, 1987, the Office of the Secretary of Education has directed the following: The Association of Philippine College Educators (APCPE) and the National Union of Teachers (NUT) have been directed to conduct a survey on the status of human rights education in the tertiary level. The survey should be completed by October 28, 1987. The survey report should be submitted to the Office of the Secretary of Education, Manila.

2. The Office of the Secretary of Education is directed to respond to the Office of Human Rights Education at the tertiary level, and to the Office of the Secretary of Education.

- a. To provide the human rights program in the Philippines. (Distribution of the human rights curriculum to all tertiary level schools)
- b. To ensure that the curriculum, specifically human rights, and subsequent responsibilities of the tertiary level are met and to ensure that the tertiary level curriculum is developed in accordance with the Office of the Secretary of Education.
- c. To ensure that the curriculum is being implemented in the tertiary level schools.
- d. To ensure that the curriculum is being implemented in the tertiary level schools.

3. The participants are school administrators, senior and junior faculty, DECS officials from both central and regional offices particularly educational attachés from the Higher Education Division.

4. Registration fee per participant is P200.00 (including snacks, lunches and handouts) or P120.00 (excluding snacks and lunches). Transportation, per trip and other allowable expenses of participants from government institutions must be charged against local funds subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures. Participants from the private institutions shall make their own arrangements with their respective schools.

5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
