COLLEGE ENGLISH TEACHERS ASSOCIATION ANNUAL CONVENTION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The College English Teachers Association (CETA), in cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports through the Bureau of Higher Education, will hold its annual convention at Marikina Sarcos State University in Cavite, from October 27-29. The theme of this convention is "Teaching English and the New Constitution: Problems and Prospects".

2. The participants of this activity will be teachers of English of colleges and universities.

3. The objectives of the convention are:

- a. to heighten college English teachers' competence in teaching English teaching to the new Constitution;
- b. to give teachers appreciation, problems and prospects for teaching English on the tertiary level; and
- c. to identify the areas of curriculum and instruction which need improvement and demonstrate the techniques and strategies that will best achieve the objective.

4. The registration fee per participant is \$100.00 to cover handbook and certificate of participation. Expenses incurred by participants from the state colleges and universities will be chargeable against their local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures while those from private schools will have to make arrangements with their respective schools.
