CELEBRATION OF "LORENZO RUIZ MONTH"

1. The Filipino Layperson, Lorenzo Ruiz, shall be elevated to the altar by canonization on October 13, 1987 by His Holiness Pope John Paul II in the Vatican City. Hence, let us堪celebrate his history as the first Filipino martyr for the Faith and the first Filipino saint. He was beatified last February 18, 1981 in Manila.

2. In view of the importance of the event to a very large sector of the Philippine Society, President Corazon C. Aquino signed Proclamation No. 148 declaring the period from September 26 to October 13 as "Lorenzo Ruiz Month." The celebration of the October 13 events will last until December 8, 1987.

3. Lorenzo Ruiz, native of Manila, married and father of three children, was martyred in Japan in 1622 because he refused to renounce his Christian Faith. He told his executioners that he was ready to die for God and give up for Him many thousands of lives if he had them.

4. Because of his rare Christian courage, heroic virtue and tenacity of spirit, which exemplifies the Filipino character at its noblest and loftiest measure, he is also considered a living legend of the Filipino people. In view of the important emphasis on traditional values thrust in the educational system, the人生 message of Lorenzo Ruiz should be included in classroom studies, especially in the Social Studies subject area.

5. An exhibit on the life and martydom of Lorenzo Ruiz is being set up in the Cathedral Building at Intramuros, Manila. Schools in Metro Manila are invited to bring their students to view the exhibits which is highly educational and instructive.
