DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS

I. DI Program Implementing Officer

1. Direct and supervise the over-all implementation and operation of a Technical and Vocational Education (National/Regional Center or TVEI).
2. Plan, develop and initiate development of a comprehensive research and planning guidelines for technical and vocational education.
3. Set up a comprehensive and systematized data bank as ready reference for planning and general information.
4. Plan, develop and/or initiate the development training programs.
5. Initiate the setting up of a core of trainers.
6. Initiate, coordinate and help the conduct of the various in-service and staff development training activities.
7. Coordinate, monitor and evaluate activities of various vocational/technical education institutions in their conduct of in-service programs.
8. Perform other functions and duties as directed.

II. National/Regional Center for DI Program Implementation Officer

In addition to the above duties and responsibilities assigned to DI Program Implementing Officers (PIO), those in the centers are tasked to perform the following:

1. Lead the other technical vocational schools relative to the implementation of the technical vocational courses in the center's service area.
2. Act as consultant in the conduct of various in-service and staff development activities.
3. Extend technical assistance in terms of planning, curriculum development, research and program evaluation.
